Extra costs listed above, if any, will be paid in a one-time, non-refundable sum of \$ and/or a monthly facilities charge of \$ which will terminate at the end of this initial contract.

This agreement, when signed by the member-owner and by an authorized representative of Pee Dee Electric Cooperative, Inc., shall become a contract under which Pee Dee Electric Cooperative, Inc., agrees to furnish the outdoor lighting service indicated to the individual member-owner and the member-owner agrees to receive and pay for said service in accordance with the terms of rate schedule "SLS-6" and the service regulations which may be modified from time to time, which rate schedule and service regulation are hereby made a part of this contract as effectually as if fully set forth herein.

The cooperative will provide outdoor lighting service as indicated, but in the event said service shall wholly or partially be interrupted or suspended or fail by reason of any fixtures burning out or being broken, or by reason of any cause beyond the control of Pee Dee Electric Cooperative, Inc., and not attributable to its neglect, or in the event Pee Dee Electric Cooperative, Inc., shall deem it necessary to suspend said service for the purpose of inspecting its lines, substations and other apparatus, or making repairs or alterations thereon or connection therewith, then and in any such event Pee Dee Electric Cooperative, Inc., shall not be liable for any damage or loss resulting therefrom; provided, that Pee Dee Electric Cooperative, Inc., will replace burned-out fixtures and otherwise maintain the fixtures (excess vandalism excepted) during regular daytime working hours as soon as practicable following notification by the member-owner of the necessity.

It is further agreed that the Cooperative reserves to itself the right to discontinue service and remove its apparatus from the premises of the member-owner in case of violation of any of the terms of said service regulations, rate schedules, or this agreement.

If at any time the member-owner would like to have the light relocated, a minimum of \$200.00 fee will be paid for the relocation.

The original term of contract will be two (2) years and thereafter until terminated by either party on 30-day notice.

The undersigned hereby certifies that he or she has marked all hazards, infrastructure, and vulnerable areas of the property, including – but not limited to septic tanks, that is not easily identifiable by Pee Dee Electric Cooperative personnel.

The undersigned hereby releases and discharges Pee Dee Electric Cooperative, Inc., its employee, officers, trustees, agents, legal representatives, successors and assigns from and against any and all liabilities or claims which may arise by reason of said entry.

The undersigned hereby warrants that he or she has the lawful authority to permit entry upon and to claims relative to the subject property.

This release shall become effective on the date signed and shall remain in effect for (1) year.
